Please find the overview for the whole school and individual classes for next week:

### Individual Class Information

**Federation Morning: Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March: Opera Cast Workshop:** All children will need to arrive at St. Lawrence's site for registration at 08.45. Beech and Willow Class will then be transported back up to Priddy during the morning for lunch. Collection times from each site will be as normal.

**Breakfast Club will be at Priddy at 08.00 until the bus leaves at 08.15.**

If you live in Priddy, then a minibus will leave Priddy at 8.15. Please contact the school office by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March if you would like your child/ren to travel down from Priddy on Monday. We apologise for the short notice; this is due to us not being able to use the Village Hall.
