Individual Class Information

Willow Class: Monday 29th June: All children in **Willow Class** will need to be registered at St. Lawrence's School Site as they are participating in an art workshop all day in the school hall with artists 'The Lost Giants.' This workshop will contribute to the work displayed and paraded at Priddy Folk Festival. Thank you to those parents who have contacted the school office to notify whether they will need the minibus. Thanking you in advance.

Willow Class: Tuesday 30th June: swimming for Willow Class. Don't forget your swimming kit, swimming hat, towel and goggles. Hair also needs to be tied up.

Holly Class: Tuesday 30th June: will be participating in an art workshop all day in the school hall with artists 'The Lost Giants.' This workshop will contribute to the work displayed and paraded at Priddy Folk Festival.

PM: Mr Thomas will be working across KS2 in the afternoon

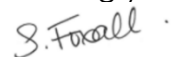
