Green Cow Café Shift Information:

Firstly, thank you so much for volunteering to help at the café and supporting the PTA. Please find below information about the weekend and the roles that we will all need to cover.

The morning shift is 7am until 11.30am on Saturday & Sunday. The lunch shift is 11.30am until 16.00pm Saturday & Sunday. The evening shift is 16.00pm until 20.30pm Friday & Saturday.

The cafe is situated on Priddy Green. As you are coming down from the school, it is the big white marquee on the right-hand side of the Green (map below). It may be best to park at the school and walk down from there or you can park at the official festival car park (also shown on the map). Car sharing maybe a good option if you can.

Please note that mobile reception is quite poor on Priddy Green.



On your shift, you will be given an apron to wear. There might be some green cow t-shirts to purchase, but only a few are left. You will have a nominated team leader who will be introduced to you on the day. Their job is to support you and always be on hand.

There will be a variety of tasks that you may be asked to do. These include cooking (warming up food and cooking baked potatoes), chopping vegetables, serving food, taking payments, serving teas and coffees, preparing cake displays, washing-up, etc. There may also be times when tables will need to be cleared and cleaned, and bins will need to be emptied.

Preparation for the next shift may also be required (for example, people on the breakfast shift will start preparing food for the lunch shift).

If you or your family would like to eat from the Green Cow, please ensure that you pay for this at the end of your shift. We are fundraising and need to ensure that all our proceeds go towards the school.

Tea and coffee are complimentary on your shift, but cartons and cans will need to be paid for please.

We ask that no alcohol is consumed during your shift please.
