What is Spelling Frame?

Spelling Frame is an engaging online platform that helps children learn their spellings in a fun and interactive way. It follows the National Curriculum spelling lists for each year group and allows children to practise words through a variety of games, activities, and tests designed to reinforce their understanding and accuracy.

Each child now has their own individual login, which has been securely stuck inside the front cover of their reading record. This will allow them to access Spelling Frame from home, so they can continue to build their confidence with the spellings we are learning in class.
